



The following guidelines apply to students grades 5-12:

- Students must have an ID badge on their person at all times while on school grounds during the school day. Students who do not have an ID badge may be denied admission to school events.
- Students must present their ID badges to a school official upon request.
- Students who display their ID badges during school hours may be eligible for random incentives at school discretion.
- Students who repeatedly fail to have ID badges will be subject to more severe sanctions/consequences.
- ID badges are not hall passes. However, students may be required to show their ID in addition to the school's hall pass policies.
- Schools may require ID badges to be used to access school programs such as library, food service, and other functions as technology-based applications increase.
- Schools may charge a \$5.00 fee for replacement of lost ID badges.
